Fifty years ago in June 1956, Sab Shimono, SHS Student Body President, was a member of Sac High's 1956 Centennial graduating class. Sac High was the stepping stone to Sab's graduation from UC Berkeley, and a move to New York to study acting. Sab played "Wang Ta" in *Flower Drum Song*.

And his first Broadway role was "Ito" in *Mame*. He has appeared in: *Gung Ho*, *Presumed Innocent*, *Come See the Paradise*, *The Big Hit*, *Paradise Road*, *The Shadow*, and *Suture*. He played the voice of "Uncle" for five seasons on Fox's *Jackie Chan Adventures* and

the voice of "Chow Lo" in Disney's *Mulan*.

Sab won a Clio Award for best actor, and awards from *LA Weekly* and *Drama-Logue*. He has performed in a wide-array of TV projects, and continues to be active in local, regional, Broadway, and Off-Broadway theater.
