2010-2011 School Year Starts August 2, 2010

- The School Choice Program provides students with the opportunity to attend a school other than their school of residence.
- Students may apply to any small school within Sac High, which includes: 1) School of Math, Engineering and Health Sciences, 2) School of the Arts, 3) Business and Communications and 4) Law and Public Service. Completing and submitting an application does not guarantee enrollment in the school of choice.
- Enrollment is on a space available basis according to grade level and/or program/course.
- School bus transportation is not provided. It is the parent's responsibility to ensure their child gets to and from school.

ENROLLMENT

PRE-ENROLLMENT PERIOD: The Pre- Enrollment Period for the 2010-2011 school year is November 2, 2009 to February 26, 2010. Applications received between November 2, 2009 and February 26, 2010 will be counted to determine the need for a public random drawing (lottery drawing). Applications must be completely filled out, signed, and include all required supporting documents. Applications must be physically submitted to the Sac High main office by 4:30 pm February 26, 2010 (postmark will not suffice). **SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION DURING THE PRE-ENROLLMENT PERIOD DOES NOT GUARANTEE ENROLLMENT.**

DRAWING DAY: If it is determined that there is space available for all applicants as of February 26, 2010 in all grades levels, no public random drawing will take place. However, if there are more applicants than available spaces in a grade level, a public random drawing will be held on March 1, 2010. Each student will be assigned a computer-generated random number for this drawing. Participants in the lottery need not be present in order to gain enrollment or to be placed on the wait list.

ENROLLMENT OFFERS: Welcome/acceptance letters will be sent to students for whom we have confirmed available space after March 1, 2010. Final enrollment will be contingent upon attendance at a summer orientation and summer bridge program. If a lottery drawing takes place, any students who are not selected for immediate enrollment through the drawing will be placed on a waiting list in the order they are drawn. Students will be offered enrollment on a rolling basis as spaces become available. Parents will be notified after March 1, 2010 of their status and place on the wait list if the drawing is necessary.

APPLICATIONS RECEIVED AFTER MARCH 1, 2010: Applications received on or after March 1, 2010 will be added to the waiting list by date and time submitted (application **MUST** be complete to be placed on the wait list). Enrollment will be offered to students by grade level availability and/or program/course availability. Families will be notified of acceptance on a rolling basis as space is available.

APPLICATIONS RECEIVED ON/AFTER AUGUST 2, 2010: Applicants submitting applications on or after August 2, 2010 (first day of school) will be added to the wait list and offered enrollment as space is available. Enrollment may be limited to term and semester start dates for the remainder of the 2010-2011 school year (due to course credit structure).

ENROLLMENT PRIORITIES: In the event that the number of students wishing to attend Sac High exceeds the school's capacity in either grade level or program/course availability, enrollment priority will be given in the following order:

1. Children of St. HOPE Public Schools' faculty and staff
2. Siblings of a concurrently enrolled student (Siblings are students who share a biological or adoptive parent/guardian).
3. Students who have attended PS7 in the past two years
4. Pupils who reside in the district
5. Pupils placed on the wait list the previous year
6. The general public

Maintenance of the Waiting List: The school will maintain the waiting list until October 31, 2010. After October 31, the list will expire and a new Pre-Enrollment Period will start for the following school year. It is the parent's duties and responsibilities to contact the school to update any contact information. Students that are not offered enrollment must complete and submit an application for the following year.

School Transfers: A student who is currently enrolled in one of the St. HOPE schools, who wishes to attend another St. HOPE school **MUST** apply to that school and will be treated as a new applicant. Students must submit their application within the Pre-Enrollment Period to receive enrollment priorities.

Notice of Non-discriminatory Policy: Sac High admits students of any race, color, national or ethnic origin, primary language, gender, disability or achievement level.

Students with Special Needs: No students will be denied admission to Sac High based on disability. Applications with special needs will be processed according to the Special Education policies and procedures of St. HOPE and the Sacramento City Unified School District.
