

Sacramento High School 2005-2006 Uniform Dress Code

Overview

A student's dress and general appearance should not draw undesirable attention to the student, nor should dress and appearance detract or interfere with teaching and the learning environment. It is expected that all students shall maintain their appearance and clothing in a modest, clean and age-appropriate fashion consistent with our dress code and compatible with the instructional program.

Benefits of School Uniforms

Positively impacts student achievement

Establishes a friendly and professional atmosphere that promotes pride, respect and safety

Instills a sense of community to which students belong

Increases safety by preventing gang colors

Decreases violence and theft because of clothing and shoes

Creates level playing field among students

Helps school officials recognize those who do not belong on campus

WHAT YOU CAN WEAR

Black pants (Dockers style)

Tan pants (Dockers style)

Black skirts

Tan skirts

Black shorts (Dockers style)

Tan shorts (Dockers style)

Skirts/shorts may be no higher than 3 inches above the knee

Black, white or purple Sac High polo-shirt, with School designation

Black, brown, white or purple shoes or athletic shoes

Black, white or purple jackets

Sacramento High School sweatshirts

Shoes must have a back strap

Shirts must be tucked in

Shirts worn under a Sacramento High School polo must be black, white or purple

Pants, skirts and shorts must be worn at the natural waist, with a belt and fit appropriately

WHAT YOU CANNOT WEAR

Jeans/Denim of any color

Jean jackets of any color

Shoes with colored stripes other than Sac High colors

Skirts with slits

Ripped outfits or outfits with holes

Shoes without a back strap, including flip-flops

Sagging pants or over-sized pants

Clothing that compromises modesty, including but not limited to: short shorts/short skirts, bare-midriff, bare backs, off the shoulder tank tops or blouses, halter tops, fishnet tops, see through tops or spaghetti straps

Bandannas, sunglasses, combs, hair scarves, hairnets, curlers, sweatbands and wave caps

PE clothing (except in PE)

Gang related symbols, insignias and other gang apparel

Sandals with skinny spiked heels

Tight clothing

Cargo pants, cargo shorts or cargo skirts

Hair styles that interfere with the learning environment

Stretch pants, shirts, shorts, skirts

Professional or college paraphernalia, FUBU, M&M or DADA (no matter what color)

Unbuttoned blouses/shirts

Hoods/hats/caps

Sweatpants
